LESSON TOPIC: CONNECTIONS IN COMPLEX SENTENCES

#### LEARNING OBJECTIVE/S:

- GAIN SYNTACTIC AWARENESS WITHIN A COMPLEX SENTENCE
- UNDERSTAND SEQUENCES AND RELATIONS
- WRITE THEIR OWN SENTENCES

#### **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- 'TEN BLACK DOTS' BY DONALD CREWS
- SENTENCE CARDS OR WORD CHUNKS
- DRAWING SUPPLIES

#### **MENTOR SENTENCE:**

FOUR DOTS CAN MAKE SEEDS FROM WHICH FLOWERS GROW

#### FOCUS QUESTION/S:

WHAT DO YOU THINK THE SENTENCE IS SAYING?
HOW DO THE DOTS MAKE SEEDS?

#### **LESSON STRUCTURE:**

#### INTRODUCTION

- DO A READ ALOUD OF 'TEN BLACK DOTS' BY DONALD CREWS, FOCUS ON HOW THE DOTS ARE USED IN CREATIVE WAYS
- FOCUS ON THE SENTENCE 'FOUR DOTS CAN MAKE SEEDS FROM WHICH FLOWERS GROW'
- ASK FOCUS QUESTIONS, EXPAND THROUGH CONVERSATION CUES, ENCOURAGE PEERS TO DISCUSS WITH EACH OTHER WHAT THEY THINK THE SENTENCE OR CHUNKS MEAN

#### LANGUAGE DIVE

- BREAK DOWN THE SENTENCE INTO CHUNKS
- FOUR DOTS, CAN MAKE SEEDS, FROM WHICH, FLOWERS GROW
- ASK ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR EACH CHUNK, THE MEANING OF EACH, HOW
   'FROM WHICH' FORMS A CONNECTION
- ASK STUDENTS TO ACT OUT THE SENTENCE WITH HAND AND BODY MOVEMENTS

#### IMAGE CONNECTION

- ASK STUDENTS TO DRAW FOUR DOTS AND HOW THEY IMAGINE SEEDS GROWING INTO FLOWERS OR PLANTS
- ASK THEM TO LABEL PARTS IN THEIR DRAWING TAKEN FROM THE CHUNK

# LESSON PLAN

#### LESSON CONTINUED:

### RECONSTRUCT (I DO, WE DO, YOU DO)

- SCRAMBLE THE CHUNKS OF THE SENTENCE AND RECREATE THE SENTENCE,
   REFER BACK TO VISUAL CUES FROM EARLIER
- ILLUSTRATE HOW 'FROM WHICH' CONNECTS THE DIFFERENT IDEAS FROM THE SENTENCE

## CREATE NEW SENTENCES (I DO, WE DO, YOU DO)

- ILLUSTRATE HOW TO CREATE NEW SENTENCES \_\_\_ DOTS CAN MAKE \_\_\_ FROM WHICH \_\_\_ GROW.
- CREATE NEW SENTENCES TOGETHER, USING CONVERSATION CUES TO ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE.
- STUDENTS CAN WRITE THERE OWN SENTENCES IN THEIR JOURNAL OR WRITER'S NOTEBOOK.

#### REFLECTION CLASS DISCUSSION

- HAVE STUDENTS SHARE SOME SENTENCES THEY CREATED
- CLOSURE DISCUSSION ON WHAT WAS LEARNED ON HOW TO CREATE NEW SENTENCE, ASK PROMPT QUESTIONS TO INCREASE ENGAGEMENT

#### EXIT SLIP:

THINK ABOUT THE SENTENCE WE LEARNED TODAY, 'FOUR DOTS CAN MAKE SEEDS FROM WHICH FLOWERS GROW.'

- CAN YOU WRITE YOU OWN SENTENCE USING THE WORDS YOU LEARNED TODAY (SEEDS)?
- WHAT DID YOU LEARN ABOUT HOW SENTENCES WORK TODAY?
- WAS THERE PART OF THE SENTENCE OR LESSON WAS CONFUSING?
